Notes: In the above chart, students are counted for each degree awarded (for example, a master's and a doctoral degree) if they earn multiple degrees at varying levels OR if multiple degrees are earned at the same level but from different colleges (a bachelor's degree from CAS and WCHP.) All education certificates are classified as post-masters. Previous to 2016-17 some were reported as post-baccalaureate in error. Beginning in 2017-18, Master of Social Work online degrees are awarded through College of Graduate and Professional Studies; in prior years, this degree was awarded through Westbrook College of Health Professions. Degree year includes August, December and May graduates. Beginning 2020-21, Pharmacy degrees awarded through Westbrook College of Health Professions.
